# **Poster Instructions**

- 1. Go to the botanical gardens (Jardin des plantes)
- 2. Walk around and take pictures of plants and their corresponding signs with the name of the plant (I have provided samples)
- 3. Choose a plant
- 4. Google Translate the name of the plant into English, French, and its scientific name
- 5. Open a white poster background
- 6. Create a rectangle the takes up the upper 2/3 of the page and make it one of the three green colors
- 7. On the green rectangle make the three names (English, french, scientific) fit in a straight line next to each other on the poster and put these words in white, then right below that, create the line of works again with the outline being white and the inside be green
- 8. Repeat this sequence as many times as can fit vertically while still being legible and also leave some space at the bottom
- 9. At the bottom 1/3 of the page include the Jardin des Plantes Logo, address, and times that it is open
- 10. Above the logo, address, and the hours of operation add the line of names in green and then add the line of names with a green outline and white inside



### What is it?

The Jardin des plantes (French for 'Garden of the Plants'), also known as the jardin des plantes de Paris when distinguished from other jardins des plantes in other cities, is the main botanical garden in France.
